Introit : Psalm 66:4

Omnis terra adoret te, Deus, et psallat tibi: psalmum dicat nomini tuo, Altissime. Ps. Iubilate Deo omnis terra, psalmum dicite nomini eius: date gloriam laudi eius.

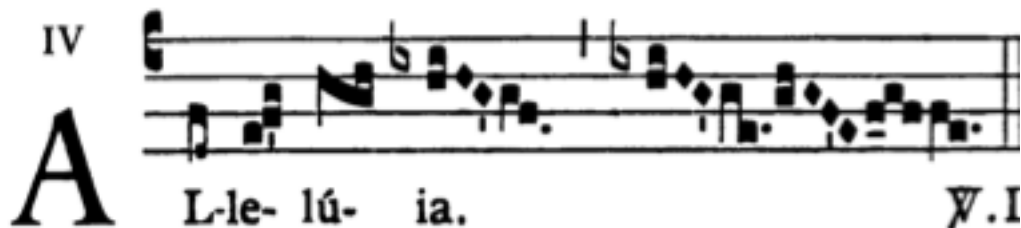
All the earth shall bow down before you, O God, and shall sing to you, shall sing to your name, O Most High! Shout joyfully to God all the earth; sing a psalm in honour of his name; praise him with magnificence.

Gradual Psalm 106. 20–21

MISIT Dóminus verbum suum et sanávit eos: et erípuit eos de intéritu eórum. V. Confiteántur Dómino misericórdiæ ejus: et mirabília ejus fíliis hóminum.

The Lord sent His word, and healed them: and delivered them from their destruction. V. Let the mercies of the Lord give glory to Him: and His wonderful works to the children of men.

Alleluia Psalm 148. 2



Laudáte Dóminum, omnes Angeli ejus: laudáte eum, omnes virtútes ejus.

Praise ye the Lord, all His Angels: praise ye Him, all His hosts.

Offertory Psalm 66:1b,2a,16

Iubilate Deo universa terra: iubilate Deo universa terra: psalmum dicite nomine eius: venite, et audite, et narrabo vobis, omnes quit timetis Deum, quanta fecit Dominus animæ meæ, alleluia.

Shout joyfully to God, all you on earth, sing praise to the glory of his name. Hear now, all you who fear God, while I declare what he has done for my soul.

Communion Jn 1:41–42

Dicit Andreas Simoni fratri suo: Invenimus Messiam, qui dicitur Christus: et adduxit eum ad Iesum.

Andrew said to his brother Simon: "we have found the Messiah" (which means Christ); and he led him to Jesus.
