

GRADUALE ROMANUM – PROPER OF THE MASS
3rd Sunday Ordinary Time – YEAR B

Introit : Mt 4:18.19 Ps 18:2

Dominus secus mare Galilaeae vidit duos fratres, Petrum et Andream, et vocavit eos: Venite post me: faciam vos fieri piscatores hominum.

Ps. Cæli enarrant gloriam Dei: et opera manuum eius annuntiat firmamentum.

The Lord, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brothers, Peter and Andrew, and he called out to them: "follow me, and I will make you fishers of men". The heavens declare the glory of God, and the firmament proclaims the work of his hands.

Gradual Psalm 101. 16–17

TIMÉBUNT gentes nomen tuum, Dómine, et omnes reges terræ glóriam tuam. V. Quóniam ædificávit Dóminus Sion: et vidébitur in majestáte sua.

The nations shall fear Thy name, O Lord, and all the kings of the earth Thy glory. V. For the Lord hath built up Sion: and He shall be seen in His glory.

Alleluia Psalm 96. 1

Dominus regnávít, exsúltet terra: læténtur ínsulæ multæ.

The Lord hath reigned, let the earth rejoice: let many islands be glad.

Offertory Psalm 118:16–17

Dextera Domini fecit virtutem, dextera Domini exaltavit me: non moriar, sed vivam, et narrabo opera Domini.

The right hand of the Lord is exalted; the right hand of the Lord has struck with power. I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord.

Communion Mt 4:19–20

Venite post me: faciam vos piscatores hominum: at illi, relictis retibus et navi, secuti sunt Dominum.

"Follow me; I will make you fishers of men". Whereupon they, leaving their nets and their boats, followed the Lord.
