

GRADUALE ROMANUM – PROPER OF THE MASS
5th Sunday Ordinary Time – YEAR B

Introit : Psalm 95:6–7

Venite adoremus Deum, et procidamus ante Dominum: ploremus ante eum, qui fecit nos: quia ipse est Dominus Deus noster. Ps. Venite, exsultemus Domino: iubilemus Deo salutari nostro.

O come, let us worship God and bow low before the God who made us, for he is the Lord our God. Vs. Come, let us sing to the Lord; let us make a joyful noise unto God our Saviour.

Gradual Ps 95: 8.9 vs Ps 28:9

Tollite hostias et introite in atria eius : adorare Dominum in aula sancta eius. Revelavit Dominus condensa, et in templo eius omnes dicent gloriam.

Bring your offerings and come into his court; worship the Lord in his holy dwelling place v. The Lord shall strip bare the thick forests and in his temple all shall proclaim his glory.

Offertory Psalm 17:5,6b,7

Communion Lk 6:17–19

Multitudo languentium, et qui vexabantur a spiritibus immundis, veniebant ad eum: quia virtus de illo exibat, et sanabat omnes.
